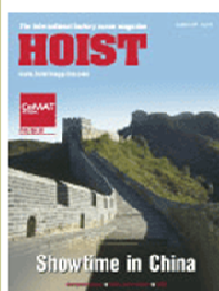
Jenmon receives offshore order
